- WHEREAS, Campbell Outdoor Recreation Association continues to be interested in and supportive of the Tennessee Elk Restoration project, and;
- WHEREAS, Elk viewing enjoys wide public support in other states, and;
- WHEREAS, the restoration of elk to Tennessee has great historical significance, and;
- WHEREAS, an elk viewing area is in the best interest of the restoration project and the public, and;
- WHEREAS, the Hatfield Knob area on Peabody Mountain is an ideal site, being easily accessible and topographically suitable for the purpose, and;
- WHEREAS, a minimal safety zone around the site will be sufficient during the elk viewing season, and;
- WHEREAS, the site can be used for other purposes during non-viewing seasons, and;
- WHEREAS, Campbell Outdoor Recreation Association along with other private and governmental entities are willing to furnish manpower, equipment and funds to the project, now;
- THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Campbell Outdoor Recreation Association recommends to the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency the establishment of a Wildlife and Elk Viewing area at the Hatfield Knob on Peabody Mountain and pledge its support to the project
