WHEREAS, CORA has always opposed any sales of public land for private development, and

WHEREAS, lands available for use by the public are dwindling rapidly, and

WHEREAS, CORA strongly believes the long term welfare of the public is better served by retaining public lands for outdoor recreation, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that CORA strongly urges TVA to retain ownership and control of lands owned by it and to dedicate them to legitimate outdoor recreation uses by the public.
