WHEREAS, the adverse economic impact is greater than the supposed savings, and;

WHEREAS, the public welfare would be better served by opening the parks,

THEREFORE, be it resolved that Campbell Outdoor Recreation Association at its regular meeting on October 2, 2001 unanimously adopts this resolution urging the State of Tennessee to reopen its public parks all across the state and especially Norris, Cove Lake and Indian Mountain parks.
