RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, suitable habitat for quail and other field game has diminished in recent years, and;

WHEREAS, small game hunting with dogs is an important and time honored sport for many Tennesseans, and;

WHEREAS, more emphasis on small game and the needs of small game hunters is desirable, and;

WHEREAS, this type of hunting supported the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency and Commission before big game stocking programs were successful, and;

WHEREAS, field game hunters and dog users deserve more consideration in planning seasons and habitat enhancement, and;

WHEREAS, a substantial reservoir of volunteers are willing to commit time, equipment and funds to enhancing suitable areas for small game, and;

WHEREAS, many such open areas capable of supporting field game population exist on Royal Blue Wildlife Management Area, Cove Creek Wildlife Refuge, and the Don Sundquist Outdoor Recreation Area, now;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Campbell Outdoor Recreation Association formally requests the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency to devote more time and resources to field game programs and to work with local volunteer groups willing to furnish manpower, equipment and funds to small game restoration efforts, and;

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that fair and balanced consideration be given to small game hunters in the fixing of seasons and establishment of restoration and stocking programs.
